Approval of Budget for Richland Collegiate High School (RCHS) for 2019-20

The Chancellor recommends that the Board of Trustees adopt the attached resolution approving the budget for 2019-20.

Background

The Richland Collegiate High School will enroll its fourteenth incoming junior class this fall semester. The new proposed budget reflects state funding projections in accordance with House Bill 3 (HB 3) passed by the 86th Texas Legislature. Budgeted expenditures have been divided between functional areas to align with the needs of the RCHS. A public hearing on the 2019-20 budget was held on Tuesday, August 6, 2019, as an earlier agenda item.

The proposed 2019-20 budget is \$5,080,328. The estimated expenditures for 2019-20 are in functional areas that relate to TEA categories as follows:
