Enrichment and certification classes for a lifetime of learning.

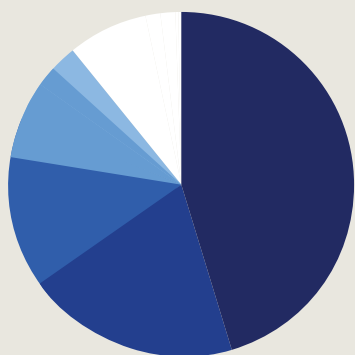

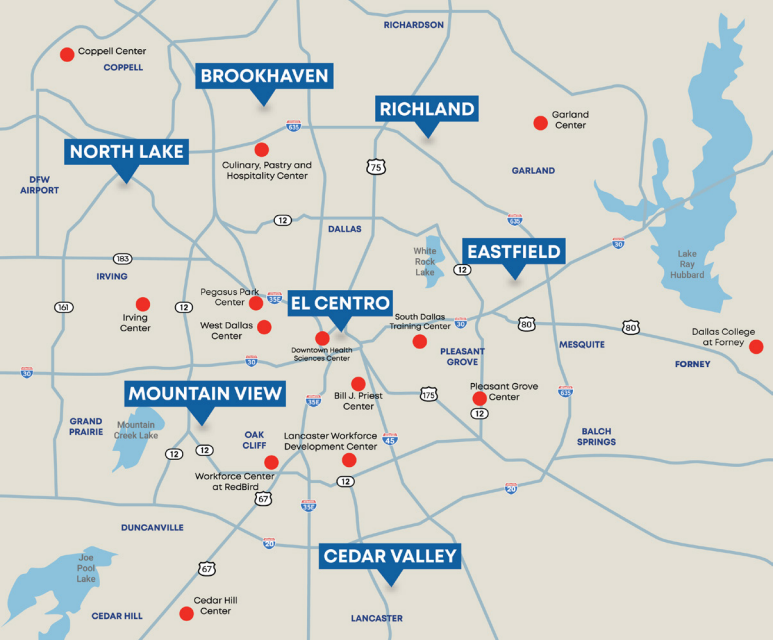
