2 Felony and controlled-substance conviction certification

To receive a Texas Educational Opportunity Grant (TEOG), a student must meet the conviction-related eligibility requirements below. These requirements apply to any felony conviction or any offense under the law of any jurisdiction involving a controlled substance as defined by Texas Health and Safety Code, Chapter 481. Select one:

- ☐ **NO CONVICTION:** I have not been convicted of an offense described above.
- ☐ **ELIGIBLE - TWO-YEAR CONDITION:** I was convicted, but at least two years have passed since I received a certificate of discharge or completed court-ordered probation.
- ☐ **ELIGIBLE - PARDON OR OTHER RELEASE:** I was convicted, but I was pardoned, the record was expunged, or I was otherwise released from the resulting state-aid ineligibility.
- ☐ **REVIEW NEEDED:** I was convicted and do not meet either condition above, or I am unsure. Dallas College should review my eligibility.

If you select an eligible exception or request review, Financial Aid must verify your status before TEOG funds are released and may contact you for supporting documentation. Do not submit sensitive court or correctional records by unapproved email.

3 Child support certification

Under Texas Family Code Section 231.006, a person who is obligated to pay child support and is more than 30 days delinquent cannot receive a state-funded grant or loan unless an applicable repayment agreement, court order, or court-approved exemption makes the person eligible. Select one:

- ☐ **ELIGIBLE:** I am not more than 30 days delinquent, or I am complying with a written repayment agreement or court order, or a court has granted an applicable exemption.
- ☐ **INELIGIBLE:** I am obligated to pay child support, I am more than 30 days delinquent, and none of the eligibility conditions above currently applies.
