- The state has identified 8 measures of accountability related to student success.

Eight Accountability Measures

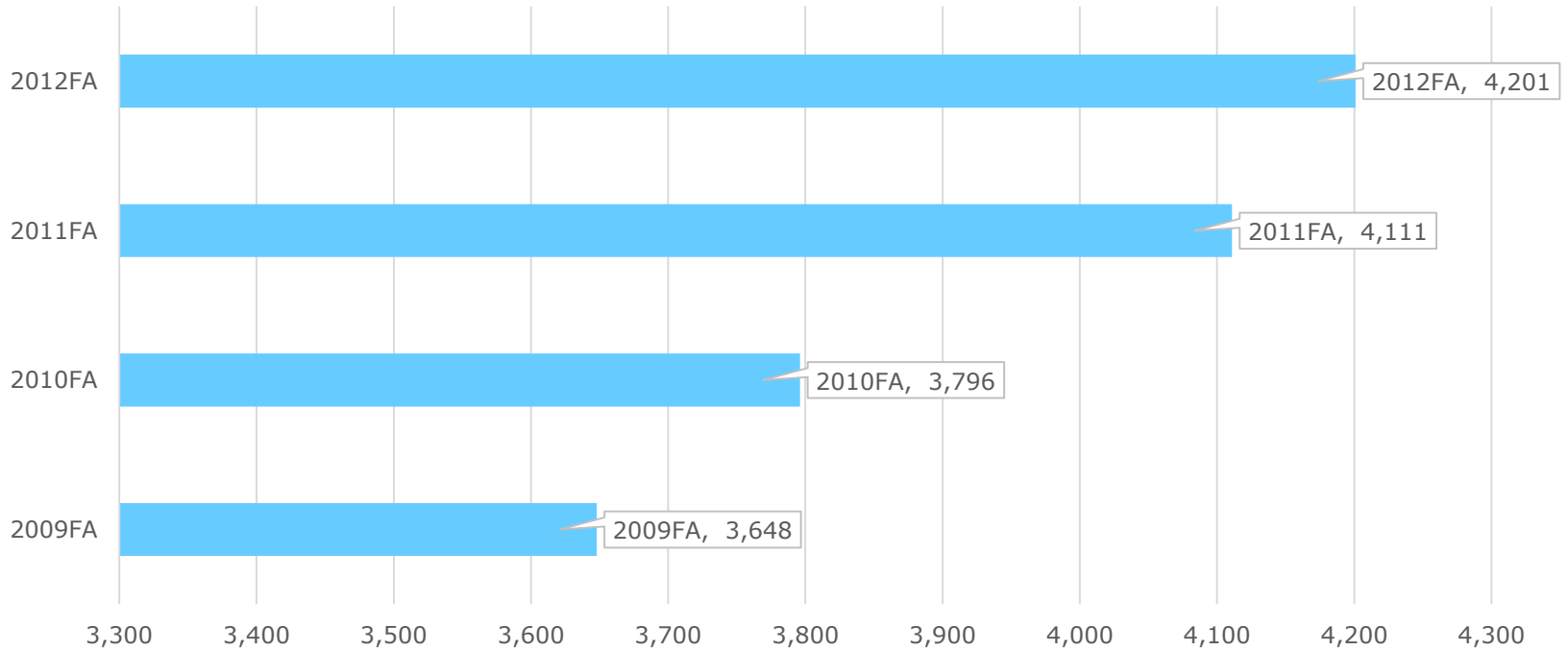
1. College Readiness

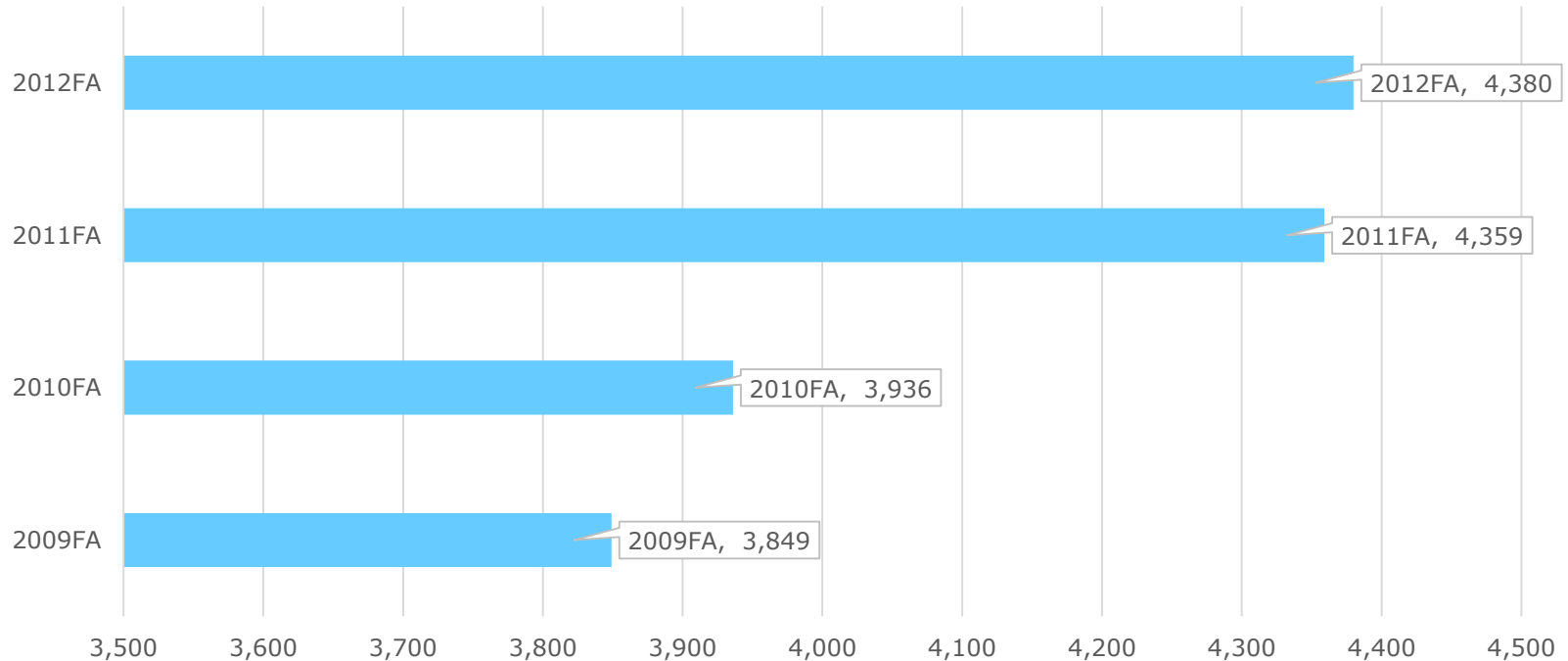
Fall TSI Completions

First College Level Math

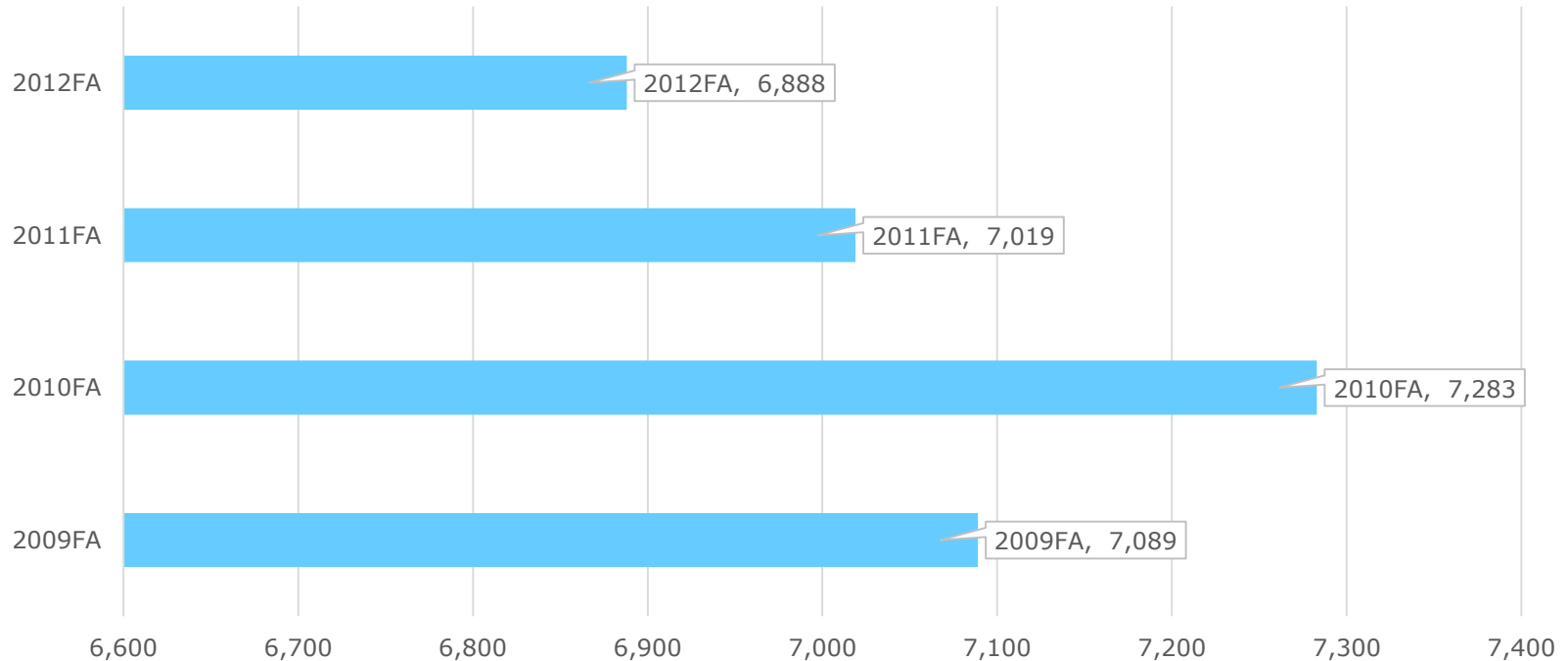
Fall Comparison First College Level Math

First College Level Reading/Writing

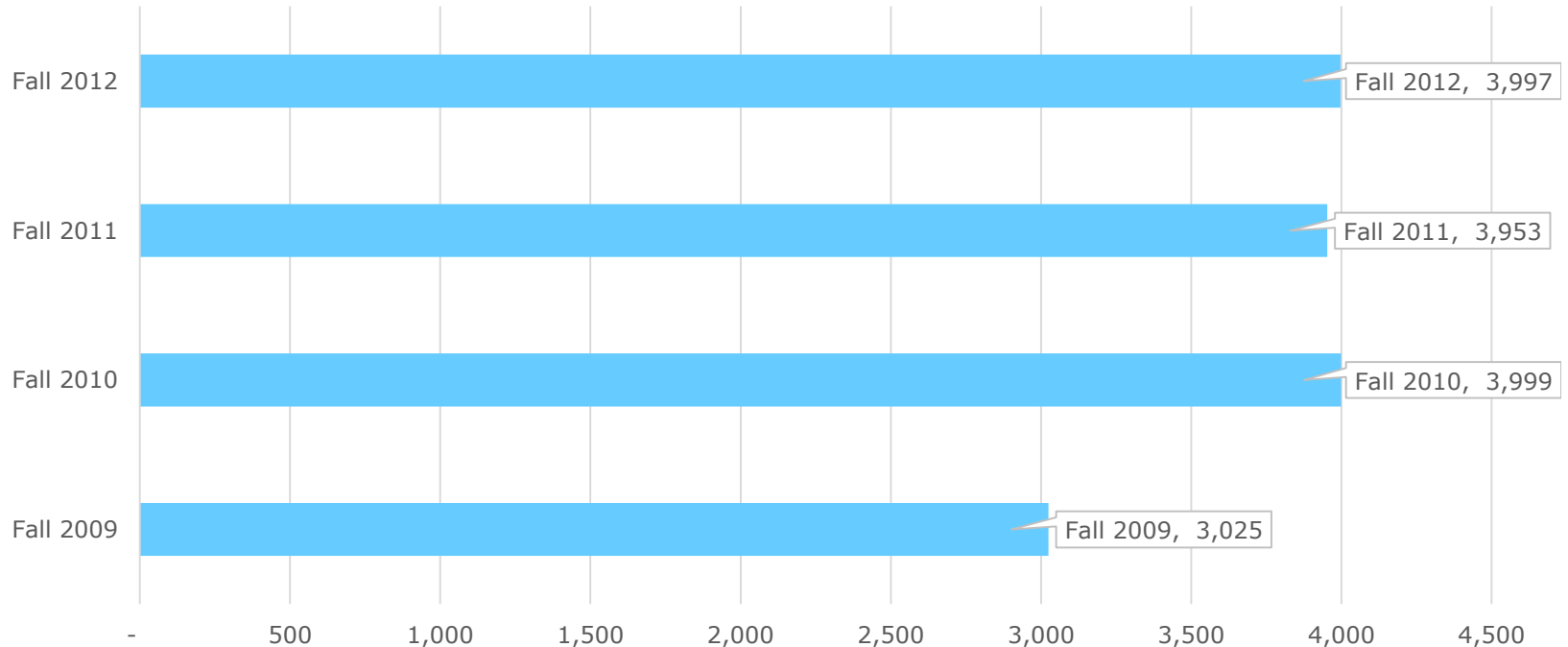
Fall Comparison First College Level Reading/Writing

Degrees, Core Completers, & Certifications

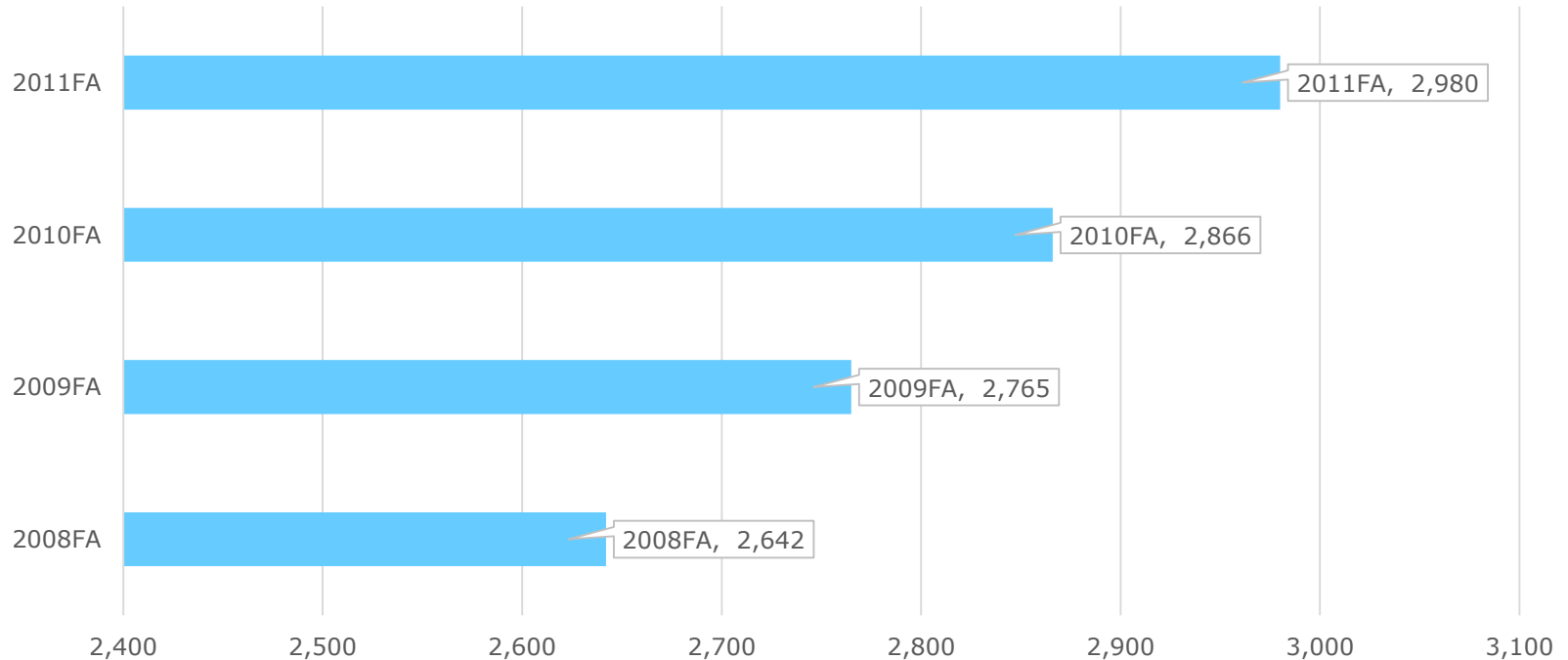
Fall Awards & Core Completions
