WHEREAS, a trustees election was held within Dallas County Community College District on May 13, 2006 to elect one (1) member of the Board of Trustees in District 1; and

Section 3. That after the canvass of votes by the Board and completion of election certification, the Chairman of the Board of Trustees shall promptly prepare and issue to the person named in Section 2. of this resolution a Certificate of Election, and after such person makes the required statement disavowing bribery which is filed with the Secretary to the Board of Trustees and takes the required oath of office, such person shall occupy District 1, as member of the Board of Trustees of Dallas County Community College District, and is entitled to serve for a period of six years.

Section 4. That this resolution is effective upon adoption by the Board of Trustees of Dallas County Community College District.
